

Installing Docker on Ubuntu 22.04

Overview

This is a simple step-by-step guide to install Docker on a Debian system.

Prerequisites

- A Debian server
- Sudo privileges
- An internet connection

Installation Steps

1. Update and upgrade packages and install curl:

```
apt update && apt upgrade -y && apt install curl -y
```

2. Download and execute the Docker installation script using `curl`:

```
curl -sSL https://get.docker.com | CHANNEL=stable bash
```

3. Verify your installation. If done correctly, you will see something similar to:

```
~ docker --version  
> Docker version 24.0.2, build cb74dfc
```

```
~ docker compose version
```

```
> Docker Compose version v2.18.1
```

That's it, Docker is now installed :)
